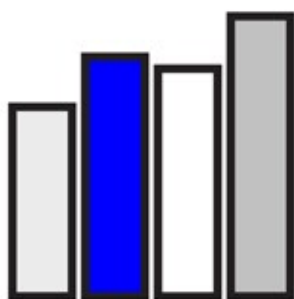

### Contest Rules

<All entries must be submitted to a librarian and logged in at the Palisades Branch Library Information Desk by September 3, 2019.

<Entries may be short stories, essays, non-fiction articles, dramatic scenes, monologues, or poetry. THE ONLY REQUIREMENT IS THAT THE ENTRY BE SET IN THE PALISADES!

<Contestants are limited to one entry not to exceed three pages (double spaced only) typed in font size 12. Use 8 x 11 inch white paper and use only one side. Please number the pages.

<Typed entries are preferred, but handwritten entries by younger contestants are acceptable. Sounded out but misspelled words are acceptable for younger entrants. Entries which an adult has clearly written will be disqualified. The charm of many entries is in the creative mistakes of a beginning writer.

<Contestants may work in small groups but only one prize will be awarded if the entry receives a prize.

<Each entry must have a completed entry form as a cover page and a legible contact email address. Do not place contestant's name or any other identification on the entry itself.

<Contestants may consult a dictionary, thesaurus, or other reference source, but they may not copy any published work. A non-fiction entry should have sources if necessary.

<Entries with profanity will be disqualified.

<Entries cannot be returned. Please keep a copy of your work.

<Contestants may not submit entries that have won prizes in other contests.

<Entries become the property of the PPLA. By entering the contest, contestants give permission for stories to be read aloud at the awards ceremony with video of the stories posted to the Friends Youtube channel, published in the local newspaper, kept in the library for interested readers, and published at [www.friendsofpalibrary.org](http://www.friendsofpalibrary.org).
