## **Pali Knitting and Crochet Group**

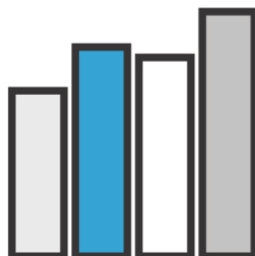
